

Literacy: - The three little pigs

During the literacy lessons children will be continuing practising how to use their phonics knowledge to read and write, **using phase 2,3,5 phonemes** independently. We will be developing our reading fluency. Through storytelling the children will be retelling the story of The three little pigs.. They are focussing on the characters we care about .They will be using adjectives, conjunctions (and, because) contractions (I'll, can't, didn't)and writing question and exclamation sentences.

Science: During this term we will be identifying, analysing and comparing every day materials and discussing their properties. We will be grouping and classifying materials based on similar properties and how suitable they are for different purposes. The children will also develop their scientific language.

Maths - Number and Place value.

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Children will recap on numbers to 20, count objects to 100 by making 10. Begin to recognise tens and ones. Partition numbers to 100 and write numbers to 100 in words. Recap counting in 2s, 5s and 10s and then learn how to count in 3s.


Art and Design
