

English

In English we will be writing a non-chronological report and short narrative about one of the medical superheroes we are focusing on. We will look in greater detail at Florence Nightingale and Mary Seacole creating comparisons between the two.

Phonics: Practise looking for the different sounds when reading together. Go on a phonic hunt. Practise Phase 4, 5 and 6 sounds and words.

Science: Animals including humans

The children will be learning about animals and humans this half term. We will look at how animals and humans grow and how we can classify animals into certain groups. We are also going to explore exercise and why it is important for humans. To assist this, we are also going to discuss the importance of a balanced diet and good hygiene.

Computing

In computing we will be looking at online safety. The children will learn about their digital foot print and how to protect themselves while online. They will also explore using search engines and how to send messages via email.

DT

In DT we will be looking at healthy foods with the intention of designing our own healthy Caribbean fruit salad inspired by Mary Seacole. We will be grouping foods according to the food groups.

PE

In PE the children will be continuing their learning of PE games, focussing on agility, speed, team work and rules. They will also be learning new gymnastic skills including balance and form.

History

In History we will be looking at significant figures in medical/nursing history. We will focus around the work and stories of Florence Nightingale, Mary Seacole and Annie Brewster,

PSHE

The children will be discussing hopes, dreams and goals. We will use real life representations to create discussion and build confidence,

Maths

In maths we will be looking at multiplication and division. The children will also be looking at money. They will work out amounts using pence and pounds and solve money related problems.

Remember to practise counting in 2's, 5's and 10's.

Topic 3: Our topic is going to be about Books within the Church. Some of the key questions we will be looking at are:

What books do you see when you are in Church?

Why are these books important? How are these different books used?

Have a look at your Bible in your home and find your favourite story.
