

English

During this topic the children will be learning the story of 'Strength'. We will be retelling the story focussing on the mood and emotion. In our non-fiction writing, the children will be learning how to write persuasively looking initially at posters. The children will then be learning to write a letter to persuade people to care for God's world.

RSHE

This term our topic is 'Relationships'. We will be looking at the relationships the children have in their families, friendships, and with people who help us. We will be exploring appropriate physical touch and when it is appropriate to keep secrets.

Geography

We will be investigating what is happening to our planet, the impact of humans, and why we should care. We will be looking at the impact of key 'Environmental Superheroes' including David Attenborough, Isatou Ceesay, Greta Thunberg, and William Kamkwambe. The children will be identifying problems in their local area and working together on a solution.

Environmental Superheroes

Core Text: Strength

Science

In Science we will be investigating properties of materials, and looking at how we can use materials to look after God's world.
