

### English

The children will be writing a recount of their trip to Littlehampton beach. To support our topic the children will learn the storytelling story 'The island of faeries'. They will use this premise of this story to create their own version. The children will use their investigations of British plants to create an information leaflet.

### Science: Materials

The children will be looking at a variety of common, wild and garden plants. They will identify the basic structure of flowers and plants. The children will have the opportunity to observe how plants grow while also finding out what plants need to grow. This will be further cemented by the children having the chance to grow their own plant.

### Computing

In our computing topic the children will be using their knowledge and understanding to create simple and more complex animations using 2Sequence. The pupils can use 2Sequence to explore harmony and build up musical scores

### PSHE

The topic this half term is 'Journey of love' where they will focus on friendships.

### DT

In DT this term we will be looking at puppets. The children will learn that there are different types of puppets. They will know that puppets are made from different parts. They will also have the opportunity to make drawings and label different parts of puppets.

### History

In history we will be looking at seaside's 100 years ago. We will explore what people did and what some of the main attractions were. The children will then compare sea sides from the past with ones of today.

### Geography

We will be looking at features of a coastline. These will cover both human and physical features. The children will also be using aerial photographs to recognise landmarks.

### Maths

The children will be looking at fractions starting with fractions of shape. They will then go on to explore fractions of a number focusing mainly on quarters, thirds and halves. In this half term we will also revisit time and look at different forms of measurement.

### PE

The children will be working on their hand eye co-ordination to take part in team games that involve a bat and a ball. They will play in team games that require them to follow basic rules to support their team.
