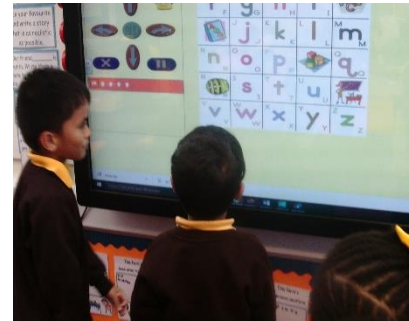

Pupils online safety agreement

For my personal safety at school and at home



- I will ask permission from a member of staff before using the Internet at school.
- I am aware of "stranger danger" when on line and will not agree to meet anyone online.
- I will tell an adult about anything online which makes me feel sad or uncomfortable.
- I will not try to bypass the system to reach websites the school has blocked.
- I understand that the school may check my files and may monitor the pages I visit.
- I will not share any pictures or videos of myself or my friends. If I am in school, I will always check with a teacher before posting anything online.
- I will not put my "Personal Information" online. (My full name, birthday, phone number, address, postcode, school etc.)

To keep the system safe



- I will only use my own login and password whenever required and I will keep them secret.
- I will not access other people's files on the computer.
- I will not play games on a school computer unless my teacher has given me permission.
- I will not attempt to install software on school computers or iPads.

Responsibility to others

- The messages I send at home and at school will be polite and responsible.
- I will not upload images or videos of other people or any platforms.
- I understand that the school may take action against me if I am involved in inappropriate behaviour on the internet and mobile devices.



Personal Devices

- The school cannot accept responsibility for loss or damage to personal devices.
- It is not permitted for pupils to use mobile phones during the school day. Phones should not be brought into school unless there is a genuine reason for doing so and my parents have approved this. If I have to bring my phone into school, I will hand it into the school office at and get it back at the end of the school day.
- Other devices (e.g. Games, cameras) should not be brought into school.
